Porthia produces organically grown Extra Virgin Olive Oil. Our produce comes solely from *Koroneiki olives*, which have been recognized for their exceptional taste. Every processing phase is carefully monitored, from preparing compost to feed the trees and carefully selecting the fruit to cold pressed methods of extraction in certified local mills and on-site storage.
